

RULES AND REGULATIONS

FOR

THE GUIDANCE OF PERSONS EMPLOYED BY THE
NORTH-EASTERN RAILWAY COMPANY.

As it is of the utmost importance that all Persons in the employment of the NORTH EASTERN RAILWAY COMPANY, both on the Main Line and Branches, and on the Lines worked by or Leased to them, should be well acquainted with the following **Rules**, every Engineman, Fireman, Guard, Policeman, Platelayer, Gatekeeper, Pointman, Stationmaster, Porter, and other person employed by the Railway Company, is strictly enjoined to **Read** the whole over **at least once a Month**, as no plea of ignorance of any Rule will be allowed as an extenuation of a fault, but be rather considered as an aggravation of it.

1. The Rules and Regulations hereafter given are arranged under different heads, for the use of Servants engaged in the various departments; but every Servant in each department is required to make himself thoroughly acquainted with **the whole**.
