

Passengers are also Booked FROM AND TO BLACKHEATH HILL (FOR GREENWICH) and LEWISHAM ROAD AT THE SAME FARES, and must travel by Local Trains to and from Brixton or Elephant and Castle, changing at these Stations to and from the Cheap Fast Trains.

The Return Tickets will be available for the Return Journey on the second following day, and there need be NO FRIDAY or SATURDAY will be available for the Return Journey on the following MONDAY by Cheap Fast Train, or on SUNDAY, by Trains leaving VICTORIA at 3.30 a.m., HOLBORN VIADUCT at 3.10 a.m., LUDGATE HILL at 3.17 a.m., and RAMSGATE at 3.00 p.m. These tickets will be available only by the Cheap Trains, and if used by other Trains the difference of fare will be charged.

CHEAP RETURN TICKETS issued from LONDON on FRIDAY or SATURDAY are available for the Return Journey by Special Express Train on Monday morning, leaving Ramsgate at 1.20 a.m., Broadstairs at 1.30 a.m., Margate at 1.35 a.m., and Herne Bay at 1.45 a.m., arriving at Victoria and Ludgate Hill at 3.10 a.m., and Holborn Viaduct at 3.17 a.m., on payment of 2s. 6d. on a first class and 1s. 6d. on a third class Cheap Ticket.

On SATURDAY a SPECIAL FAST TRAIN in the MORNING leaves the HOLBORN VIADUCT at 3.10 p.m., and Victoria and Ludgate Hill at 3.17 p.m.

FREQUENT TRAINS run between the Suburban Stations on the GREAT NORTHERN, MIDLAND, and SOUTH WESTERN RAILWAYS and SNOW HILL (Holborn Viaduct) or BLACKHEATH HILL, also between Stations on the GREAT WESTERN and NORTH WESTERN RAILWAYS and VICTORIA. Trains every few minutes between Victoria, Westminster, Charing Cross, North Kensington (the South Kensington, Museum, West, Royal, Co., St. James's Park, Kensington, Notting Hill, and Paddington), by METROPOLITAN RAILWAY.

Through Tickets to Cheap Fares are also issued in connection with these Trains from and to the principal Stations in the G.N. and Mid. suburban districts.

The Cheap Fast Return Tickets issued by the L.C. and D. and S.E. Companies between Victoria, Holborn Viaduct, Ludgate Hill, and Moorgate Street, Charing Cross Cannon Street, Waterloo Junction, and London Bridge, and Margate and Broadstairs, and vice versa, are available for the Return Journey by the Trains of either Company, according to description and Class.

These Tickets can also be obtained at Messrs. Cook and Son's Tourist Office, Ludgate Circus.
